## Rule of the Week

### Footwork – Rule 13

A sound knowledge of the footwork rule is essential for an umpire. It's equally important that you are able to recognise infringements of this rule. Learn to view the whole player, not just the hands or feet.

- Recognise the moment of gaining possession of the ball
- Recognise the landed foot
- Be aware of the time from gaining possession of the ball to the moment of release.
