


# **Final's Rules**

#### 3. Floating or replacement players

- 3.1 Players not wishing to join a team may register as an Association floating player.
  - 3.1.1 Teams may use a floating player if they do not have seven players of their own to take the court to replace a registered team member at the approval of at least 3 selectors.
  - 3.1.2 Failure to seek approval will result in a forfeit for the team concerned.
- 3.2 Replacement players can either be another registered player or a non-registered player.
  - 3.2.1 Teams may use another registered player if they do not have seven players of their own to take the court to replace a registered team member at the approval of at least 3 selectors
  - 3.2.2 Failure to seek approval will result in a forfeit for the team concerned.
  - 3.2.3 Teams may use a non-registered player. This player does not need approval by selectors.
  - 3.2.4 A non-registered player can only play up to 2 games before they must then register with the Association.

#### 6. Finals

- 6.1 In the event of a draw during the semis, finals and grand finals
  - 6.1.1 After a 2 minute interval where substitutions/changes may be made, teams change ends and play 7 minutes at each goal post with one minute interval between these two halves.
  - 6.1.2 Substitutions can be made at this one minute interval. Should the result still be another draw, play continues until one team is two points ahead. That team will be declared the winner.
- 6.2 Players playing the semis, finals and grand finals must have played the equivalent amount of games to complete a full round in their division in the same team.
- 6.3 Winning team players for the grand finals must have played or be on the side line in full uniform for one of either the semis, finals or grand finals to receive a trophy.
- 6.4 In the final series -
- 6.4.1 Regardless of the number of teams in a particular division, the top 4 teams will play off in the semi-finals, with the exception of 6.4.2.
- 6.4.1.1 1<sup>st</sup> placed plays 2<sup>nd</sup> place and 3<sup>rd</sup> placed plays 4<sup>th</sup> place. Winner of 1 and 2 goes straight into the grand final, with the loser of 3 and 4 being eliminated. The loser of 1 and 2 and the winner of 3 and 4 play off to make the grand final.
- 6.4.2 Divisions with 3 teams, 1<sup>st</sup> placed team goes straight into grand final and 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> teams play off to make the grand <u>final</u>.














# Wigs & Wine - A Night to Celebrate and Support!


