Offside – Rule 14

A player who is 'offside' is one who enters a part of the court that is not part of their playing area. They are considered to be offside whether they have the ball or not.

Remember: To be offside, a player must be OVER the line by physically contacting the ground in the offside area. On the line is ok. A player is not
